## ANNOUNCEMENT OF OAK PARK COMMUNITY EVENTS IN APRIL BILL STUFFER

On Wednesday, February 23, Director Michael Paule advised staff that TSD has been requested to use its April OPWS water bill stuffer to announce two Oak Park community events: EarthFest 2011 (April 16) and Beautification Day (April 30). The bills are scheduled to be issued on or about April 1, so inclusion of the announcements can easily be accommodated. Further, since stuffers are routinely included with the water bills, the requested announcements can be made part of the planned stuffer for April. Thus, the requests will not "bump" any previously planned water conservation messages. The front page of the stuffer will be adequate for communicating current conservation-related information. There is no added cost associated with inclusion of the community announcements beyond the usual expense for printing, folding, and inserting an 8-1/2 x 11" page (approximately \$450).

Enclosed is the requested text for the EarthFest 2011 announcement. Staff has not yet received the text for the Beautification Day announcement. We anticipate receiving it from Supervisor Linda Parks' office within the next couple of weeks. Staff will conform both announcements to match the design of the stuffer.
