2010 URBAN WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN

SUMMARY

Conduct a Public Hearing and consider adopting the Urban Water Management Plan.

BACKGROUND

The California State Legislature in 1983 passed AB 797, the Urban Water Management Planning Act (ACT) which became effective January 1, 1984. The Act requires every urban water supplier providing water for municipal purposes to more than 3,000 customers or supplying more than 3,000 acre-feet of water annually to prepare and adopt an Urban Water Management Plan (UWMP). The Act also requires urban water suppliers to update the UWMP in years ending in five or zero. The 2010 UWMP also has a requirement to report the baseline and target per capita water use reduction values to achieve the States goal of reducing water consumption 20% by 2020.

At your May 23, 2011 meeting the draft Triunfo Sanitation District /Oak Park Water UWMP was provided for review and comment along with a presentation of the requirements and content of the UWMP. Following the presentation your board requested staff to release the UWMP for public comment. Staff posted the draft UWMP on the TSD website and published a notice in the Ventura County Star. The notice informed the public that the draft UWMP was available on the TSD website along with how to provide written comment and notification of the public hearing on June 27, 2011 to consider adoption of the UWMP.

FISCAL IMPACT

The implementation of the water conservation elements included in the UWMP is included in the proposed budget for next fiscal year.



**RESOLUTION OF THE TRIUNFO SANITATION DISTRICT
TO ADOPT THE URBAN WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN**

WHEREAS, the California Legislature enacted Assembly Bill 797 (Water Code Section 10610 et seq., known as the Urban Water Management Planning Act) during the 1983-1984 Regular Session and as amended subsequently, which mandates that every supplier providing water for municipal purposes to more than 3,000 customers or supplying more than 3,000 acre-feet of water annually prepare an Urban Water Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Oak Park Water Service/Triunfo Sanitation District is a water supplier of more than 3,000 customers; and

WHEREAS, the Urban Water Management Plan is required to be periodically reviewed and updated at least once every five years; and

WHEREAS, a draft of the Urban Water Management Plan was made available for public comment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND DETERMINED by the Triunfo Sanitation District that the Oak Park Water Service/Triunfo Sanitation District Urban Water Management Plan is hereby adopted as the Urban Water Management Plan required by the State of California.

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

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Triunfo Sanitation District Board of Directors will hold a public hearing at its regular meeting on **Monday, June 27, 2011 at 5:15 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matters may be heard**, in the Film Room of the Oak Park Library, 899 North Kanan Road, Oak Park, CA. The Board of Directors will consider acceptance of the Urban Water Management Plan 2010 Update (UWMP), including (SBx7-7) Per Capita Water Use Targets and conservation strategies related to compliance with the Water Conservation Act of 2009.

The 2010 Urban Water Management Plan Update addresses the Triunfo Sanitation District / Oak Park Water Service's water resources planning responsibilities by assessing water supplies and demands over a 20-year planning horizon. The Plan also incorporates the district's drought response actions and its water shortage contingency plan. New to the 2010 Update are the legislative requirements set forth by the 20x2020 Water Conservation Plan, which call for a 20 percent per capita water use reduction by the year 2020. The Triunfo Sanitation District / Oak Park Water Service's water use reduction targets and strategies for meeting this goal will be presented during the meeting.

The Triunfo Sanitation District / Oak Park Water Service encourages interested parties to attend the public meeting and comment on the issues being discussed. If you wish to provide testimony and are unable to attend the meeting, written comments delivered to the Clerk's office prior to the hearing will be made a part of the public record. Such written comments can be mailed or hand-delivered to 1001 Partridge Drive, Suite 150, Ventura, CA 93003-0704.
