SITE SECURITY

Summary

Based on the recent vandalism that occurred at the Savoy reservoir site, Chair Paule requested a discussion regarding site security.

Background

On May 17, 2011, there was a vandalism incident at the Triunfo Sanitation District's Savoy reservoir. Damage to the site included:

- Bolt cutters were used to cut the chain locking the access gate;
- A section of barbed wire was cut from the perimeter fence;
- The reservoir ladder guard was cut;
- The equipment door to Nextel's (cellular lessee) equipment room was damaged; and
- Minor damage to Southern California Edison's electric meter.

The incident was reported to the Ventura County Sheriff who investigated and provided suggestion to improve site security. Following the incident the fence and ladder guard were repaired and staff is involving a contractor to provide estimates for additional security measures at the Savoy and other District sites.

Financial Impact

The fiscal impact will vary depending on the type of security measures implemented.
